Program Purpose

The American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED program provides participants with the knowledge and skills they need to recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac, breathing and first aid emergencies for adults, children and infants. The courses in this program teach participants the knowledge and skills needed to give immediate care to an injured or ill person and to decide whether advanced medical care is needed.

This class is a blended learning class. Participants must complete an online learning portion prior to attending the seated class, which covers skills only. Email addresses are required to complete online learning.

Participants must attend the skills portion on the dates stated to receive their certification. If you are unable to make the class, please contact Madison Bronson to move to the next class. Once a participant has begun the online learning portion, we can no longer refund the class fee.
